Dear Artisan,

We're back! Welcome to the 30th annual Lobsterfest event on Saturday November 11, 2023 at St. Thomas Episcopal Church (12200 Bailey Cove Road SE in Huntsville)

Artisan booths will be open from 10AM-4PM on the day of Lobsterfest. Setup will be on Friday or Saturday morning. All artisans will need to provide their own tables and chairs. Artisans must provide their own tents for outdoor spaces – this is a rain, shine or freeze event. There are a limited number of booths available with an electrical outlet – bring any extension cords that you might need.

Booths will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. There are three larger spaces available in the reception area just inside the front entrance. These spaces will be \$75. Indoor spaces are 10' x 4' and outdoor spaces are 10' x 10'. A single booth for both the indoor and outdoor locations is \$50. If you require two booths, the cost is \$100. We have been instructed that all indoor spaces must be filled before filling outdoor spaces. There are 18 indoor spaces and 14 outdoor spaces. Unlike previous years, there will be two outside entry points leading into the back hall.

Please mail back the two attached required documents (registration form and waiver) along with your check to: Marcia Steiner, 7803 Fair Circle SE, Huntsville, AL 35802. Checks should be made payable to St. Thomas Episcopal Church. For those who may be interested, there is a new option to pay your registration through the link on the registration form. If you choose to pay online, please remember to mail the completed registration form and signed release to me. Booths cannot be assigned until receipt of both forms and the fee. Applications will be accepted until November 1 or until all booth space is filled.
